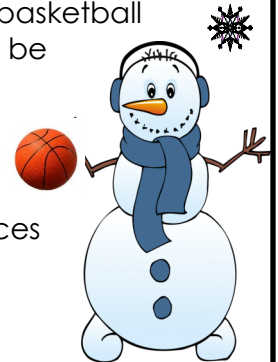

Our hot lunches for January are Dominos, Boston Pizza and Chicken Nuggets for those who have ordered. February dates and orders will be available online.



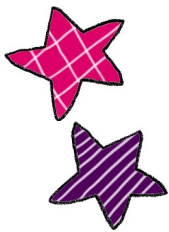
